The laws and requirements for Cosmetology & Esthetics licensing vary by state. Also, the rules for reciprocity, which is a type of transfer that means another state will allow you to work utilizing the license of your current state, also vary. Other things that vary are a transfer, when a state other than your home state of licensure allows you to perform Cosmetology & Esthetics services legally, renewal schedules, fees, regulations and continuing education requirements.

State Authorization is the determination by a higher education agency, most likely a higher education board or commission, that allows an institution to conduct certain activities within the state. The Cosmetology & Esthetics Programs at the above named institutions have Illinois State Authorization. If you plan to work in another state, outside of Illinois, you may have to meet additional requirements to be licensed in that state.
